The restoration of the W.A. Hall Store in Gardiner will serve as the new home for the Yellowstone Association. Built in 1903 and originally designed by Robert Reamer, the \$3M restoration will provide new administrative offices, education classes, meet public interpretive needs and provide a small retail space. The building lies directly at the North Entrance to Yellowstone National Park and is the foremost dominant building in Gardiner. The building will be carefully re-designed to maintain a close connection to park history and park architecture, while providing residents and visitors with a truly unique experience. This project is the final phase of Yellowstone Association's effort to streamline their administrative, education & retail supply facilities. We are currently completing a \$1.7M storage facility directly behind the new Headquarters' locations. The renovation of the W.A. Hall Store is scheduled to be completed in the Spring 2009.
